

Like all dominant dog breeds Shar Pei require socialisation and training. A lack of training is one of the common reasons for Shar Pei to be dumped or surrendered to pounds and shelters and for this reason we can't emphasize this point strongly enough.

At the bare minimum your Shar Pei should be taught to sit, drop, wait, heel and recall on command. The time invested in teaching your Shar Pei these commands will ensure that you have a faithful loyal companion for the years to follow.
